



CONSULATE-GENERAL OF JAMAICA, TORONTO

REQUIREMENTS FOR JAMAICAN CITIZENSHIP BY MARRIAGE

A non-Jamaican national is eligible to make an application for citizenship by virtue of Marriage if he or she is married to a Jamaican citizen.

The following **original** documents are required:

- Completed Application R1 Form should be completed in duplicate;

- Birth Certificate and Passport of the Jamaican National;
- Long Format Birth Certificate and Passport of the applicant (spouse);
- Marriage Certificate;
- Decree Absolute, where applicable;
- Recent (at most 6 months old) Police Record of the Applicant;
- Official Change of Name Document – Court Order, Deed Polls registered through the court or the Country's record office, etc, where applicable;
- Two (2) Passport sized photographs of the Applicant- both to be notarized by a Notary Public if you are unable to appear in person at the Consulate.

FEE

- The fee is Two Hundred and Ninety Canadian Dollars (CDN\$290.00) **money order** made payable to **PICA**
- Please note that additional cost includes a Consular fee of Thirteen Dollars (CDN\$13.00). Money order should be made payable to **Consulate General of Jamaica**

PROCESSING TIME

- Approximately 24 months. All applications are submitted to the Passport, Immigration and Citizenship Agency in Jamaica.
