



CONSULATE-GENERAL OF JAMAICA, TORONTO

REQUIREMENTS FOR FIRST TIME MINOR JAMAICAN PASSORTS

A Jamaican national is eligible to apply his or her Jamaican Passport provided that he or she is in possession of a Jamaican Birth Certificate or Certificate of Citizenship.

The following **original** documents are required:

- Completed Jamaican Passport Application Form <https://www.pica.gov.jm/sites/default/files/Forms/Jamaica-Passport-Application-Compressed.pdf>
- Birth Certificate, Adoption Certificate or Citizenship Certificate;
- Marriage Certificate (where applicable);
- Official Change of Name Document e.g. Court Order, Deed Polls registered through the Courts or the Country's Record Office (where applicable);
- Valid Government issued ID (Driver's Licence, Permanent Resident Card or Passport) of parent making application;
- Two (2) identical passport sized photographs certified by a Notary Public, Justice of the Peace, Commissioner of Oaths, Medical Doctor and Minister of Religion who is authorized to perform marriages. A Consular Officer may certify the application and photographs if the individual appears in person.

FEE

- Fifty Canadian Dollars (CDN\$50.00) money order made payable to **PICA**.
- Twenty-Six Canadian Dollars (CDN\$26.00) for Consular and postage. This fee is payable in cash or by debit card if you apply in person, or a **money order** payable to **Consulate-General of Jamaica** if the application is submitted by mail.

PROCESSING TIME

- Compliant applications are processed in approximately 6-8 weeks. This includes transmission to and from the Passport, Immigration and Citizenship Agency (PICA) in Jamaica. PICA reserves the right to request additional information and documentation in support of the application.
